#### Pastor's Message

Dear Church Family,

I shared this last year at this time, and it's fitting to share it again this month. A couple of years ago, I encountered this guy at the Southern Heights Food Forest. A beautiful caterpillar, bright green in color and munching away on leaves. We all know how caterpillars area bit of a pest in a garden, as they do eat the leaves of the plants that we are trying to grow. I looked him up, and it appears that he's the kind of caterpillar that will eventually become a type



of Swallowtail Butterfly, a beautiful pollinator that helps to continue the fertilization cycle of plants in our region.

I love butterflies. I love how they flit and float through the air. I love that their work at pollinating is such an incredibly important part of our ecosystem. And I love how they, and the caterpillars they come from, remind me of something so

incredibly important in my own life and relationship with God. They remind me of hope for new life. Hope in the resurrection. You see, for a caterpillar to become a butterfly, it must first seemingly die. It creates a cocoon, wrapping itself inside, and then...nothing for the longest time. The cocoon itself is dry and papery, and it feels dead. But, inside, the most amazing thing is happening. It's being made new...it is becoming a new creation altogether. And, when it emerges...it's amazing. It is no wonder that one of the oldest symbols of Christ and the Resurrection are butterflies.

Caterpillars and butterflies are a reminder for me, and for us, that this is what's happening in us in God and Christ.

That, in our lives in Christ, we are caterpillars entering into a cocoon, being wrapped in the Holy Spirit, and being made into a new creation. We are being made dead to sin, and alive to all that is good.

We are being made into butterflies. Beautiful, beautiful butterflies that speak to hope, new life, and resurrection. This Easter Season, as we see caterpillars in our gardens and butterflies in the air, let us stop for a moment and be thankful that Christ is transforming us into something new, and that we are becoming butterflies, witnesses to the hope and joy we find in the new life in Christ.






