





### **Treasurer's Report**

Revenue is behind in the first month of the new year but entirely expected since we usually get off to a slow start. Bottom line is negative, mostly caused by the booking of Deacon mission fund to the STIFIT Fund.

Deacons funds were funded via journal entries in January. The budgeted amount for Deacons Fund of \$300 was added to the STIFIT fund balance and the reset of the Deacons Mission fund to \$2000 was funded by local mission. We had more than adequate savings in the STIFIT account to fund these transactions that are normal at the beginning of a year.

We have not received any new prepaid giving for 2024, only a couple received in 2023 for 2024. I am hoping that we will receive prepaid giving in February and March that will again allow us to put money in STIFIT savings to help with operating funds if we encounter cash flow problems later in the year.

Just some accounting notes. I have decided to leave prepaid estimates and Bell Tower income in the liability section of the balance sheet. Prior years I have moved these accounting transactions to below the line but that then tends to overstate the final bottom line in any given month.


